Any dog license fees paid more than once or paid in excess of the amount due will be refunded by the tax collector within 30 days after the date of payment. No dog licenses will be issued and no refunds will be made without proper or complete supporting documents.

NOTE: You may not renew your dog's license past the Rabies Expiration date!

For example, if your dog's rabies vaccine is only valid for 1 year from today's date, then you may only purchase a 1 year license. If the rabies vaccine is valid for 3 years from today's date, then you may purchase a 1, 2 or 3 year license.

- If the rabies vaccine expires in less than a year do I wait until it expires to get the license or do I just purchase 1 year?
 - You would purchase only 1 year and when the rabies expires be sure to send us a copy of the new rabies certificate in order to keep the license tag current.
- If I am a senior and I sent in a copy of my license the last time I renewed my dog's license, do I have to send another copy of my license?
 - No you do not, if you sent it in the last time it should be in your file in our system.
- What if my dog was spayed/neutered before I adopted her/him and I don't have the certificate, how do I show proof of sterilization?
 - Ask your vet to write a letter stating that their office did not perform the surgery but after examining her/him they can see the scar indicating the surgery had been performed sometime in the past. Please provide us with a copy of this letter.
- My dog is very old and our vet believes that a rabies vaccine would do more harm than good for his/her health, what do I do?
 - In this case your vet should perform a Titer but in certain cases the vet also will not recommend this either. The vet will need to write a letter stating that in their professional opinion, administering a rabies vaccine can be harmful to the dog's health due to their age. Please provide us with a copy of this letter.
- I just renewed my dog's license a few months ago and yet I just received a renewal notice, why is this?
 - This is more than likely due to the expiration date of the rabies vaccine. Remember, the tag expiration may not exceed the rabies expiration. You will need to update the dog's rabies vaccination accordingly and then send us a copy of the new rabies certificate.
